The races are at Minooka Park, which is part of the *Waukesha County Park System*.

The course *The course starts and finishes in Picnic Area #3 of Minooka Park.* The course is a rolling course with primarily on a grass surface. Runners will cross the park roads twice. Spikes can be worn. **The course is primarily in the front half of the park and DOES NOT include the legendary difficult hill that is in Minooka Park.** The course will be lined and flagged. The course is approx. 2600 meters (1.5 miles) in length...

MEET ENTRIES... You are allowed to enter an unlimited number of athletes, in each race... **Each school will be allowed to have 10 ATHLETES use Chip Timing in each of the 6 divisions... (10 7th Grade Boy's, 10 7th Grade Girl's etc....)....** If you have additional athletes beyond 10 (they can participate you will be required to record those times, yourself....

Meet Entries: ALL MEET ENTRIES ARE HANDLED by PT Timing, LLC. All entries will be submitted on the www.pttiming.com website. 1. Click "Upcoming" Events Events 2. Click on Sept. 17th –Waukesha South/Waukesha Cross Country Festival.....Follow the directions and fill in your teams name and athlete's names. **YOU WILL BE ASKED TO SET UP AN ACCOUNT AND PASSWORD...**See below. (This is a manual process that will require entering each athlete's name. You NOT have to enter the athlete's names again, if another meet uses the PT Timing service later in the season.) **You will only be allowed to enter 10 athletes per race, online...**

IF YOU HAVE AN ACCOUNT FROM LAST YEAR or EARLIER THIS YEAR, it STILL EXISTS....

ENTRIES ARE DUE On THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 15th at 12:00 Noon....

A \$25.00 late will be assessed to all schools that submit entries AFTER the deadline

DO NOT CONTACT Waukesha South or Eric Lehmann if you MISS the entry deadline. It is your responsibility to enter your team on the www.pttiming.com website.

Chip Timing: PT Timing, LLC, will time the races. Each athlete will receive ONE CHIP to be worn on his or her shoe. Each team will be responsible returning EVERY CHIP at the end of the race. Chips will be handed out in bags and you will be expected to return the chips in the same bag.

Meet Results: One Copy of Meet Results, per school will be available. Results will be posted online at www.pttiming.com and www.trackandfieldcamps.com. Complete Meet Results will be submitted to the *Milwaukee Journal, Waukesha Freeman, and WCCCA website.*

Awards: Medals to the first 10 finishers in each GRADE and GENDER . Results will be processed and sorted for each grade and each gender. (No Team Trophy will be given out.)
